A group of researchers who work on social aspects of sickle cell disease and thalassaemia was formed in April 2010 following a conference Sickle Cell The Next 100 Years at De Montfort University in the UK. In March 2012 WISSH held its second conference in Atlanta, Georgia (USA), in conjunction with the Second National Conference of Blood Disorders and Public Health of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and a meeting of the Global Sickle Cell Disease Network.



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On Friday APRIL 11th 2014 WISSH will hold its third conference in **Rio de Janeiro Brazil in conjunction with the Global Sickle Cell Disease Network and the Brazilian Ministry of Health.**
